

Kids Safety POSTER Contest

POSTER CONTEST Program Description: Is for **4th, 5th & 6th graders**, but any elementary-age child can participate. Create a **poster focused on any one of the 7 points in “Your Responsibility Code” or any one of the 5 PARK SMART elements**. Top entries will **win a family 4 pack of tickets to Lookout Pass or The Route of the Hiawatha Scenic Bike Trail**. Other prizes will be awarded based on number of entries.

Rules for Poster Design:

- Students must create a poster based on one or more of the seven elements of “Your Responsibility Code” or five PARK SMART elements.
- Posters must be created only by an individual child or a project team of no more than 3 children.
- Use official entry form to submit entries, 8 ½” x 11” or 11” x 17” poster size is recommended.
- Students should use pencil, crayon, paint and other art materials in their poster design.
- Complete the form on the front of the poster (or else include the information on the back of poster).
- Entries can be submitted by dropping off at Lookout Pass Ticket window. A scan or photo of the poster can also be emailed to Matt@SkiLookout.com. If emailed please put the following in the Subject Line: **Lookout Pass POSTER Safety Contest** and in the body of the email the entrants name(s), age, address, and telephone number. Mail original artwork to Lookout Pass, PO Box 108, Wallace, ID 83873.
- Entry forms must be submitted on time – January 31, 2021 (this includes original paper entries that were previously emailed in. All must be received by 1/31/2021)

Judging Standards:

Winners will be selected in two categories, including Best Overall Safety Message and Most Creative Design. Selection will be based on the poster’s connection to safety, visual impact, and originality. All posters submitted will become property of Lookout Pass Ski and Recreation Area. Winners will be entered into the national contest. Winners will be announced the first week of February.

Kids Safety VIDEO Contest

Program Description: The contest is for 7th - 12th graders. Participants will be asked to create a 30 second video related to any one of the seven points in “Your Responsibility Code” or any one of the five PARK SMART elements. The top entries will win a family 4 pack of tickets to Lookout Pass or The Hiawatha Trail. Other prizes will be awarded based on number of entries.

Rules for Video Design:

- Students must create a video based on one or more of the seven elements of “Your Responsibility Code” or five PARK SMART elements.
- Videos must be created by an individual or in a team of no more than 3 - 7th to 12th graders.
- Videos entries are to be sent to Matt@SkiLookout.com and include entrants name(s), address, age, telephone number, and email. Please put: **Lookout Pass VIDEO Safety Contest** in the subject line.
- Entries must be submitted on time – January 31, 2021

Judging Standards:

Winners will be selected for overall safety message and creativity. Selection will be based on the video’s connection to safety, visual impact, and originality. All videos submitted become property of Lookout Pass Ski and Recreation Area. Winning videos will be displayed on Lookout Pass website.
